DEADLINE - Thursday, June 18th: WEST OHIO CONFERENCE - COMMUNITY COVID-19 ReENTRY KIT: This project sponsored by our St. Mark's Cares Committee is to help reduce the spread of Covid-19 through and to high risk, vulnerable populations returning back to the community.

KIT REQUIREMENTS:

One hand towel

One Washcloth

One comb (no pocket combs or picks & at least 6 inches.)

One toenail or fingernail clipper

Bath-size soap (No Ivory or Jergen's soap, (Do not remove from packaging))

Two, 2-in-1 shampoo & conditioner (travel size)

One adult toothbrush & toothpaste (Do not remove from packaging)

10 adhesive bandages (3/4 by 3 inches)

One note of hope (sign first name only, with no contact information)

One hand sanitizer (travel size [preferred] -optional)

One one-gallon size re-sealable bag.

KIT ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- * Lay hand towel flat on a table.
- * Lay the washcloth in the center of the hand towel.
- * Place all remaining items **except** plastic bag, mask, and note on top of the washcloth.
- * Fold the sides of the hand towel to cover the items.
- * Grasp the bundle tightly and roll over the remainder of the towel.
- * Write a brief note of encouragement and welcome.
- * Place the tightly rolled bundle, note & facemask (if available) in the plastic bag, where all items are visible. Remove air & seal.
- * Groups/individuals supplying only facemasks may seal them in a plastic bag to be placed in hygiene kits later.

IMPORTANT NOTES.

- * All items must be new.
- * Do not wash any of the items,
- * Please include an encouraging note and welcome.
- * Do not include your full name, address, and any personal information in your note.
- * Contents of kits or the containers of kits should not be imprinted with advertisements, patriotic, military, violent or alcoholic/tobacco symbols.

There will be a bin in Fellowship Hall for your kits. Please drop off during office hours, 9-3 weekdays or place beside kitchen door and it will be checked each day for kits.
