JULY 12-15, YOUTH MISSION WEEK

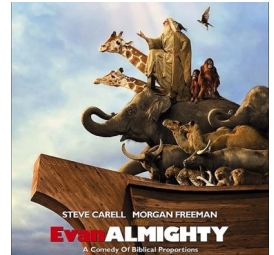
